An Act relative to the dissemination of information to private detectives..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 30A of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby  
2 amended by inserting after the word “therein,” in line 7, the following words: persons licensed  
3 by the department of state police to conduct criminal and civil investigations pursuant to section  
4 twenty-two of chapter one hundred and forty-seven.
