An Act authorizing the Massachusetts Teachers' Retirement System to grant creditable service to Sheila Blair..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of Chapter 32 of the General Laws or any  
2 other General or special laws to the contrary, the Massachusetts teachers' retirement system shall  
3 credit Sheila Blair, an employee of the Springfield Public School System, with creditable service  
4 for the service she rendered at Springfield Technical Community College from 1987 to 1999 as a  
5 program coordinator for the purpose of determining her retirement allowance.

6 SECTION 2. Eligibility for this creditable service shall be conditioned upon payment by  
7 Sheila Blair to the Massachusetts teachers' retirement system in an amount equal to that which  
8 would have been withheld as regular deductions from her regular compensation for such

9 previous service plus interest, in one lump sum or installments, as the Massachusetts teachers'

10 retirement board shall proscribe.
