Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 17 of chapter 32A is hereby amended by inserting at the end
- 2 thereof the following sentence:- The commission shall enable teacher subscribers enrolled in its
- 3 health plan pursuant to subsection (e) of section 19 of chapter 32B to choose whether to enroll in
- 4 the commission's dental plan authorized by section 17 of chapter 32A, provided it is self-funded
- 5 and said subscribers, including dependents and surviving spouses, were enrolled previously in
- 6 the dental plan pursuant to section 13 of this chapter.
