The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act authorizing the County Commissioners of Dukes County to appoint a treasurer who may not be a resident of the county.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 1 of chapter 35, section 1 of
- 2 chapter 55, section 160 of chapter 54, section 143 of chapter 54 of the General Laws, or any
- 3 other general or special law, rule, regulation to the contrary, the treasurer for the county of Dukes
- 4 County need not be a resident of the County.
- 5 SECTION 2. Upon the effective date of this Act, the current appointed treasurer shall
- 6 continue in that position and perform the duties thereof, until the expiration of the term for which
- 7 he or she was appointed. Upon a future vacancy by removal or otherwise, the commissioners
- 8 may appoint a county treasurer in accordance with section 1.
- 9 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
