An Act relative to certified appeal notices from the Department of Revenue.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1                   SECTION 1. The department of revenue shall promulgate regulations which
- 2 require the department to send correspondence giving notice of a taxpayer’s right to appeal the
- 3 department’s decision of assessment by certified mail to taxpayer’s last known address, and
- 4 impute the cost of certified mail to any penalties or fees owed by the taxpayer.
