An Act relative to inmate telephone calls.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 127 of Massachusetts General Laws of 2014 is hereby amended by  
2 adding the following section:--

3           Section 87A. The cost of local and long distance telephone service provided to prisoners  
4 in department of correction facilities and county houses of correction shall be the same as the  
5 rates charged for comparable residential telephone service. The department of correction and  
6 county houses of correction shall negotiate contracts for local and long distance telephone  
7 service on the basis of offering the lowest cost to users. The commonwealth, the department of  
8 correction, and the county houses of correction shall not accept commissions or revenues, nor  
9 receive any telephone services for their employees at below market rate cost from the provider(s)  
10 of prisoner telephone service.
