An Act relative to SMART retirement plan fees.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special act to the contrary, the state treasurer shall
- 2 establish a sliding scale for administrative fees paid by members of the deferred compensation
- 3 SMART retirement plan who are employed as call firefighters or other part-time or intermittent
- 4 emergency response personnel.
