Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Paragraph (b) of section 91 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as
- 2 appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following sentence:-
- 3 Notwithstanding any other provisions of this section, any person who is receiving a pension or
- 4 retirement allowance from the commonwealth may be employed in the service of a city, town or
- 5 district without being subject to the hours and earnings restrictions of the previous sentence.
- 6 SECTION 2. Paragraph (c) of said section 91 of said chapter 32, as so appearing, is
- 7 hereby amended by striking out the word "shall", in line 90, and inserting in place thereof the
- 8 following words:-, with the exception of any person receiving a pension or retirement allowance
- 9 from the commonwealth and employed by a city, town or district, shall
