## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act granting property tax relief to seniors.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 5 of chapter 59 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following new section:--
- Fifty-eighth. Upon the acceptance of this section by a city or town, the board of assessors
- 4 may grant real and personal property tax abatement up to 100 per cent of the total tax assessed to
- 5 a resident who has attained the age of 75, subject to eligibility criteria to be established by the
- 6 board of assessors.
