An Act promoting the use of electric vehicles.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 6 of chapter 64H of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following new
3 subsection:--

4 (yy) A battery electric vehicle, also known as an electric car, together with the battery
5 recharging station shall be exempt from the sales tax, provided, however, that the owner agrees
6 to pay a vehicle miles traveled tax established by regulation by the department of revenue
7 collected as part of any battery rental agreement.
