AN ACT REMOVING THE REQUIREMENT TO PROVIDE NOTICE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH OF A LICENSE GRANTED TO A GUARDIAN TO SELL REAL ESTATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 12 of Chapter 202 is hereby amended by deleting in the first sentence the
2 words:- or in the case of a person incapacitated by reason of mental illness.Section 12 of Chapter 202 is
3 hereby further amended by deleting in the first sentence the words:- or in the case of a person
4 incapacitated by reason of mental illness to the department of mental health.
