An Act relative to the retirement benefits.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1. Notwithstanding any general or special act to the contrary Frank Rizzo, a  
2 resident of the Town of Belmont, shall be exempt from chapter 32 section 91(b) of the General  
3 Laws.

4           Section 2. The individual named in section one shall not receive combined earnings  
5 from any public employment and any public pension or retirement allowance he may receive to  
6 exceed the salary that was being paid for the position from which he retired or in which his  
7 employment was terminated.

8           Section 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
