An Act relative to corrections officers injured in the line of duty.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. (a) Section 111F of Chapter 41 of the Massachusetts General Laws is  
2 hereby amended by adding the following in the first sentence in line 2 after the word district: “or  
3 a correction officer employed by a county or the state”

4 (b) and by adding the following in line 22 after the word officer: “or a state or county  
5 corrections officer”

6 (c) and by adding the following in line 26 after the word city: “state, county,”

7 (d) and by adding the following in line 29 after the word city: “state, county,”

8 (e) and by adding the following in line 36 after the word town: “state, county,”

9 (f) and by adding the following in line 39 after the word city: “state, county,”

10 (g) and by adding the following in line 41 after the word officer: “or a state or county  
11 corrections officer”

12 (h) and by adding the following in line 44 after the word town: “state, county,”
