### AN ACT RELATIVE TO PRIVATIZATION CONTRACTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. The first paragraph of section 54 of chapter 7 of the General Laws, as  
2 appearing in the 2002 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after paragraph (1) the  
3 following paragraph:-

4           The agency shall prepare a written statement that the services proposed to be the subject of the  
5 privatization contract shall not be performed outside the territorial limits of the United States. A  
6 privatization contract and a subsequent agreement, including an agreement resulting from a  
7 rebidding of previously privatized service or an agreement renewing or extending a privatization  
8 contract shall include:

9           (a) a provision prohibiting the person awarded the contract from performing any portion of the  
10 services proposed to be the subject of the privatization contract outside the territorial limits of the  
11 United States;

12 (b) a provision prohibiting the person awarded the contract from entering into a subcontract with  
13 any person that will perform or will have performed on its behalf any portion of the services  
14 proposed to be the subject of the privatization contract outside the territorial limits of the United  
15 States.
