AN ACT RELATIVE TO PRIVATIZATION CONTRACTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. The first paragraph of section 54 of chapter 7 of the General Laws, as
- 2 appearing in the 2002 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after paragraph (1) the
- 3 following paragraph:-
- 4 The agency shall prepare a written statement that the services proposed to be the subject of the
- 5 privatization contract shall not be performed outside the territorial limits of the United States. A
- 6 privatization contract and a subsequent agreement, including an agreement resulting from a
- 7 rebidding of previously privatized service or an agreement renewing or extending a privatization
- 8 contract shall include:
- 9 (a) a provision prohibiting the person awarded the contract from performing any portion of the
- services proposed to be the subject of the privatization contract outside the territorial limits of the
- 11 United States;

- 12 (b) a provision prohibiting the person awarded the contract from entering into a subcontract with
- any person that will perform or will have performed on its behalf any portion of the services
- proposed to be the subject of the privatization contract outside the territorial limits of the United
- 15 States.
