An Act relative to local commissions on disability.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding section 20 of chapter 30A of the General Laws or any other law or rule
2 or regulation to the contrary, a local commission on disability may by majority vote of the
3 commissioners at a regular meeting may permit remote participation applicable to a specific
4 meeting or generally to all of the commission’s meetings; provided, however, that the
5 commission shall comply with all other requirements of law.
