An Act relative to senior citizen property taxes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Clause Eighteenth of section 5 of chapter 59 of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in the 2012 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 446, the word
3 “and” and inserting in place thereof the following word:— or

4 SECTION 2. Clause Forty-first A of said section 5 of chapter 59 of the General Laws, as
5 so appearing, is hereby further amended by inserting, in line 1062, after the words “the property
6 or” the following words:— one year after

7 SECTION 3. Subsection (k) of section 6 of chapter 62 of the General Laws, as so
8 appearing, is hereby amended in line 421 by striking out the figure “10” and inserting the figure
9 “8”
