An Act designating a certain parcel in the City of Cambridge as the Lynch Family Skate Park .

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           A 28,000 square foot section of Parcel 29f directly under the loop ramps of the Zakim
- 2 Bunker Hill Memorial Bridge located in the City of Cambridge shall be designated and known as
- 3 the Lynch Family Skate Park. The Massachusetts Department of Conservation and Recreation
- 4 shall erect and maintain suitable markers bearing the designation in compliance with the
- 5 standards of the department.
