**In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen**

An Act relative to records open to public inspection.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 7 of Chapter 66 of the General Laws, is hereby amended by adding the following  
2 sentence:

3 “All records in the custody of the state secretary which are ninety years or older shall be  
4 open to public inspection.”

5 Section 2A of Chapter 46 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out, in the  
6 first sentence, the words “children born out of wedlock or” and “or those of persons born out of  
7 wedlock”.

8 Subsection 26c of Section 7 of chapter 4 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
9 inserting after the word "information" the following words: of living people; and by inserting  
10 after the word “named” the following word: living.
