Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Section 19 of Chapter 46 of the General Laws, as appearing in the General Laws, is
- 2 hereby amended by adding the following section:
- 3 "Section 19D: The custodians of birth, marriage, and death records will provide non-
- 4 certified copies of records on plain paper rather than safety paper. These copies will be marked
- 5 "for research purposes only, not to be used as evidence." The cost will be 20% of the cost of a
- 6 certified copy."
