By Mr. Eldridge, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1483) of James B. Eldridge, Cory Atkins, Jennifer E. Benson and Denise Provost for legislation to designate certain buildings in the town of Acton. State Administration and Regulatory Oversight.

An Act designating certain buildings in the town of Acton.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the
2 contrary, the family housing development that is located at 3-14 Sachem Way shall be
3 designated and known as McManus Village, in honor of the former Executive Director, in honor
4 of her dedicated years of service to the Acton Housing Authority. The Acton Housing Authority
5 shall erect and maintain suitable markers bearing the designation in compliance with the
6 standards of authority.

7 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the
8 contrary, the affordable rental housing construction, located at 15-26 Sachem Way, shall be
9 designated and known as the Whittlesey Village, in honor of the former Chairman and his years
10 of dedicated service to the Acton Housing Authority. The Acton Housing Authority shall erect
11 and maintain suitable markers bearing the designation in compliance with the standards of
12 authority.
