An Act relative to equalizing the Department of Revenue interest rates.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Paragraph (a) of section 32 of chapter 62C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the second sentence and inserting in place  
3 thereof the following sentence:-

4 If any amount of tax is not paid to the commissioner on or before its statutory due date,  
5 there shall be added to the tax interest at the rate of the federal short-term rate determined under  
6 section 6621(b) of the Internal Revenue Code, as amended and in effect for the taxable year, plus  
7 2 percentage points, computed as simple interest.
