Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 32 of the Generals Laws, as appearing in the 2008 official edition,

2 is hereby amended by inserting in section 3 (g), in line 293, after the word "supervisor," the

- 3 following new words:- associate probation officers, probation officer, assistance chief probation
- 4 officer, senior community corrections probation officer, and day reporting center probation
- 5 officer, first assistant chief probation officer, court officer I, court officer II, court officer III,
- 6 assistant and chief court officer, associate court officer, and court officer-in-charge
