*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           SECTION 1. Section 4 of Chapter 62 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008
- 2 Official Edition is hereby amended in the first line of subsection (b) by striking “5.3 per cent”
- 3 and replacing it with “five per cent”.
