An Act relative to state spending control .

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary the secretary for
- 2 administration and finance is hereby authorized and directed to develop a five year plan to
- 3 reduce the cost of operating state government by not less than 5 percent, and shall file such plan
- 4 with the senate and house committees on ways and means and the clerks of the senate and house
- 5 of representatives no later than eight months following the passage of this act.
