Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1: Section 60A of Chapter 29 as recently amended by Chapter 165 of the Acts
- 2 of 2012 is hereby amended in paragraph two by striking the number "1.05" and inserting in place
- 3 thereof the following:-"1.00"
- 4 SECTION 2: The provisions of this act shall expire five years from the date of its
- 5 passage, unless otherwise extended, modified or terminated
