An Act to increase membership in the PRIM Board.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 23 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 186, the word “nine” and inserting in  
3 place thereof the following word:- "eleven"

4           SECTION 2. Said Section 23 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is  
5 hereby further amended by inserting, in line 201, after the word “governor,” the following  
6 words:-

7           “a person appointed by the executive board of the Massachusetts Association of  
8 Contributory Retirement Systems who shall be from a regional or county retirement board that  
9 has funds in the PRIT fund, a person appointed by the executive board of the Massachusetts

- 10 Association of Contributory Retirement Systems who shall be from a municipal retirement board
- 11 that has funds in the PRIT fund,”
