An Act relative to continuing education requirements for pipefitters, refrigeration technicians, and sprinkler fitters..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 85 of chapter 146 of the General Laws, as so appearing in the 2010 Official  
2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the second paragraph the following paragraph:-

3 The Bureau shall promulgate regulations which shall require the renewal of such licenses  
4 every two years. Commencing with the license renewal on July 1, 2013, all individuals licensed  
5 by the commonwealth as a pipefitter, refrigeration technician, or sprinkler fitter shall  
6 demonstrate the satisfactory completion of continuing education courses as determined by the  
7 Bureau.
