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By Ms. Creem, petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1570) of Eldridge and Creem for legislation relative to disclosure of job recommendations [Joint Committee on State Administration and Regulatory Oversight].

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## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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In the Year Two Thousand Eleven  
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An Act relative to disclosure of job recommendations.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 268A of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the  
2 following new section:-

3           268B. Any member of the General Court or any Constitutional officer who directly or  
4 indirectly, whether in writing or by other means, recommends an individual for a position as a  
5 public employee or quasi-public employee of the state shall file a written disclosure of the name  
6 and address of the individual who is the subject of the recommendation and the position and  
7 agency for which the recommendation was given. Said disclosure shall be considered a public  
8 record 3 months after it has been filed.
