**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act relative to the use of hoisting equipment in Chapter 74 vocational technical education.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 53 of Chapter 146 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official Edition,
2 is hereby amended by inserting, after subsection (g), the following:-

3 (h) Any public high school that operates hoisting equipment as part of a vocational
4 technical education program approved under chapter 74, shall be exempt from this section if the
5 school has met the requirements of clauses (i) and (ii) of subsection (e) and the supervising
6 instructor is on site at all times of operation and holds a license issued by the division of
7 occupational licensure under this section and is designated as the responsible person in charge of
8 hoisting equipment during that period of operation.
