An Act relative to group insurance costs.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 6 of chapter 32A of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting the following new sentence: For active and retired employees, their dependents and
- 3 the survivors of deceased employees, including municipal subscribers, the maximum amount of
- 4 deductibles and copayments for covered services during an enrollment year in a plan shall not
- 5 exceed \$2,000 for individual coverage and \$4,000 for family coverage.
