**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)**

An Act to support commercial fishing.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 6 of Chapter 64H of the General Laws is hereby amended in subsection (o) by
2 inserting after the word “sales” in line 202 the words “and repairs”, and is hereby further
3 amended by adding after the word “equipment” in line 204 the words “including but not limited
4 to nets, dredges, lines, hooks, traps, wires, and any components thereof, and any fish or natural
5 or artificial material to be utilized as bait”
