An Act relative to motor vehicle registration plates.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2008 official  
2 edition is hereby amended in the seventh paragraph, line 2, by striking the words “two number  
3 plates of suitable design” and inserting the words “one number plate of suitable design to be  
4 placed at the rear of the vehicle”,

5 Section 2. Section 6 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2008 official  
6 edition is hereby amended in line 6 by striking the following words: “at the front and”.
