- SECTION 1. Section 72 of Chapter 10 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word 'commission,' in line 13, the

- 4 "Said investigators shall have all the power of a police officer in a city or town, with
- 5 reference to enforcement of the laws, excluding chapter ninety, of the commonwealth."
- 6 SECTION 2. Section 56 of Chapter 138 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby
- 7 amended by inserting after the word 'chapter,' in line 11, the following:-
- 8 "Said investigators shall have all the power of a police officer in a city or town, with
- 9 reference to enforcement of the laws, excluding chapter ninety, of the commonwealth."
