### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to water meter testing fees..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 39 I of Chapter 40 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting in the first sentence, after the words "rate for such quarter or", the word "billing"; and is
- 3 further amended in the third sentence by striking out the words "and in no case shall the expense
- 4 so required to be paid exceed three dollars for each examination and test"; and is further
- 5 amended in the third sentence by striking out the words "two per cent of accuracy" and inserting
- 6 in place thereof the following words:-"American Water Works Association (AWWA) accuracy
- 7 standards".
