An Act relative to Massachusetts certified emergency telecommunicators.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Group 2 of paragraph (g) of subdivision (2) of section 3 of chapter 32 of the General
2 Laws, as amended by section 37 of chapter 39 of the acts of 2021, is hereby amended by
3 inserting the following words after the word “hospital”, in line 266, the following words:- ; all
4 full-time dispatchers, dispatch supervisors, communications center directors or communications
5 chiefs certified by the state 911 Department as Certified Telecommunicators as defined by MA
6 560 CMR 5.04
