Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 28N of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting the following paragraph:-
- 3 (b) When any Group 4 member has applied and/or going through the accidental or
- 4 ordinary disability retirement process said member's GIC health care benefits will not be
- 5 terminated and be continued until the members retirement is approved.
