An Act relative to former state employees and elected officials.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 5(e) of Chapter 268A is hereby amended by striking the subsection  
2 in its entirety and inserting in place thereof the following: -

3 (e) a former state employee or elected official, including a former member of the general  
4 court, the governor, lieutenant governor, secretary of state, state auditor, attorney general,  
5 treasurer, or appointed executive branch commissioners and cabinet level secretaries, who acts as  
6 legislative or executive agent, as defined in section 39 of chapter 3, for anyone other than the  
7 commonwealth or a state agency before the governmental body with which he has been  
8 associated, within three years after he leaves that body, office, or position.
