## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act establishing creditable service for veterans.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 46 of chapter 30 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after subsection 1B the following section:-
- 3 "(1C) An employee with 7 years of creditable service who is a veteran, as defined by the
- 4 forty-third clause of section 7 of chapter 4, shall upon the employee's seventh anniversary of
- 5 hire, be advanced to the maximum step in the employee's job group."
- 6 SECTION 2. Any employee who, as of the effective date of this act, satisfies the
- 7 requirements of subsection 1C of section 46 of chapter 30 of the General Laws shall immediately
- 8 be advanced to the maximum step in the employee's job group.
