A majority of all the members elected to the Senate and House of Representatives, in joint session, hereby declares it to be expedient to alter the Constitution by the adoption of the following Article of Amendment, to the end that it may become a part of the Constitution [if similarly agreed to in a joint session of the next General Court and approved by the people at the state election next following]:

ARTICLE OF AMENDMENT.

- 1 The Constitution of the Commonwealth is hereby amended by eliminating
- 2 Chapter 2, Section 2 “Council, and the Manner of settling Elections by the Legislature,” of
- 3 Article XLVIII of the Amendments
