- 2 amended by inserting after section 15IIIIII the following section:-
- 3 Section 15JJJJJJ. The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting apart the
- 4 month of January as Peace Officer History Month and recommend that the month be observed in
- 5 an appropriate manner by the people.
