An Act relative to transparency in government with regard to consultant expenses.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 14C of chapter 7, as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition, is hereby
- 2 amended by inserting at the end thereof the following section:-
- 3 (i) The secretary shall list the salaries of all experts, technical consultants and other
- 4 assistants in executive offices, as defined in section 7 of chapter 6a, in the category "Employee
- 5 Payroll". The salary shall be listed under the expert, technical consultant or other assistant's
- 6 name, and not under the vendor's name.
- 7 Section 2. Section 7 of chapter 6A, as so appearing, is hereby amended by inserting at the
- 8 end thereof the following section:-
- 9 The salaries of experts, technical consultants and other assistants shall not be paid out of
- 10 the executive office's operating budget. All expenses must be funded by a separate line-item, as
- 11 defined in section 1 of chapter 29.
