**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court  
(2015-2016)**

An Act recognizing Massachusetts State Parks Day.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority  
of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 6 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition, is hereby  
2 amended by inserting after Section 15RRRRR, the following section:-

3 Section 15SSSSS. The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting apart the first  
4 Wednesday in May as Massachusetts State Parks Day in recognition of the importance to  
5 promote, enhance and maintain the Commonwealth’s park land and recreational facilities,  
6 aiming to create a world class parks system, and recommend that the day be observed in an  
7 appropriate manner by the people.
