An Act relative to the composition of the Group Insurance Commission.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 3 of chapter 32A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by striking out in line 5 the words “and 13 members” and inserting in place
- 3 thereof, the words:- the president of the Retired State, County and Municipal Employees
- 4 Association of Massachusetts or a designee, and 12 members.
