In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act relative to shelter benefits for veterans.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 115, Section 5 of the Massachusetts General Laws, as appearing in
2 the 2004 Official edition is hereby amended by striking out paragraph eight and inserting in
3 place thereof the following paragraphs: --

4 The benefits provided herein shall include an amount for “Shelter” not to fall below \$600
5 per month for eligible veterans and dependents who do not pay their own heating costs.

6 The benefits provided herein shall include an amount for “Shelter” not to fall below \$500
7 per month for eligible veterans and dependents who pay their own heating costs.
