An Act relative to the retirement of MassPort officers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1            Subsection (g) of subsection (2) of section 3 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as  
2            appearing in the 2018 Official Edition, is hereby further amended by inserting after the words  
3            “assistant fire control men” the following words:-

4            employees of the Massachusetts Port Authority who are employed as port officers and  
5            supervisors of said employees who shall include port sergeants, lieutenants, captains, assistant  
6            chiefs, deputy chiefs, and director.
