## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

**In the Year Two Thousand Eleven**

An Act relative to the protection of pedestrians at crosswalks..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 25 of chapter 83 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-

3 Cities and towns shall provide reflective lights at crosswalks to ensure the safety of  
4 pedestrians traveling on the public ways within a municipality. The reflective light shall be of  
5 such design as the commissioner of highways determines necessary for the safe crossing of  
6 pedestrians.
