An Act relative to the transfer of boat registration between family members..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 3 of Chapter 90B of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 inserting, after subsection (e), the following:-

3 Except when the change of ownership of the motorboat is between two family members,  
4 the previous certificate of number may be kept at the request of the new owner of the motorboat.
