Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 3 of chapter 62 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 official edition, is
- 2 hereby amended in subparagraph (9) by adding the following sentence at the end thereof:- Said
- 3 deduction shall be available to a resident shareholder of a housing cooperative organized under
- 4 chapter 156B or chapter 157 who has resided in his or her cooperative unit throughout the tax
- 5 year and has not claimed a deduction for real estate taxes or mortgage interest on the resident
- 6 shareholder's federal income tax return.
