By Mr. Richard T. Moore, a petition (subject to Joint Rule 12) of Richard T. Moore and Kevin J. Kuros for legislation to establish a sick leave bank for Kevin Russell, an employee of the Department of Revenue. Public Service.

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Kevin Russell, an employee of the Department of Revenue.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish a sick leave bank for an employee of the department of revenue, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the
2 contrary, the department of revenue shall establish a sick leave bank for Kevin Russell, an
3 employee of the department. Any employee of the department may voluntarily contribute 1 or
4 more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Kevin Russell. Whenever
5 Kevin Russell terminates employment with the department or requests to dissolve the sick leave
6 bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended illness leave
7 bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability
8 that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the department.
